On September 10, 2011 I was called to examine all 12 horses present at the SYV Horseback rides location in Buellton CA. The 12 I examined included the 3 of concern- Biscuit, Gandolf, and Fame and Fortune. I did not see any signs of abuse or neglect on any of the horses present. The only mildly thin horse was Gandolf and the personnel had a good nutritional plan in place for him. Some of the horses are older horses with normal "wear and tear" ailments but again, the personnel seem to have their management well in hand. If you have further questions or need more specifics please feel free to contact me.

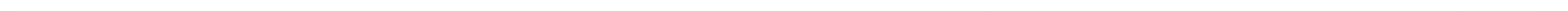

Dear Dr.

I need a small, quick favor, and it's a bit urgent. I need your written statement of your recommended treatment for a mare of ours that showed lameness. I emailed you radiographs that you reviewed, and we subsequently spoke on the phone and you made pertinent suggestions. Simply, I need you to write down what you told me.

Here's a recap to help refresh your memory:

June 30, I sent you the email below along with radiographs from an _____ report. I asked you to review and suggest any courses of action to help overcome her lameness. You suggested two potential treatments, the first was daily _____ and reshoeing to change the angle of her club foot, and adding a pad and potentially a wedge. You said you would welcome a call from our farrier _____ to instruct him how to trim and shoe her. (_____ said he tried to reach you, but never succeeded.)

Failing that treatment, you suggested a shot of _____ to increase joint lubrication.

The initial treatment worked, the mare was given a month off, was reshod with pads and returned to use in early August and has shown no lameness at the walk and very mild lameness when trotting in a circle. She continues to improve.

Lastly, there is an urgency to this request. We have been accused of animal abuse involving this horse and requested Animal Services review all our horses and practices. They did, and exonerated us of all

issues. However, the mare's vet record does not show your recommendation, and only show's Dr. recommendation she be retired from use. Since then, Dr. (our usual vet) has seen her twice and stated she has overcome her lameness and is sound to use at the walk.

Here's the urgency: We are moving our facility to the River View Park in Buellton and on Thursday are up for a final vote before the Planning Commission to receive our Conditional Use Permit. Animal Services is ready to issue their report exonerating us, but need to connect the dots on the mare's treatment. Your statement is the missing link. If you can get this to me tonight or early tomorrow, it will resolve my issue. The Planning Commission and City Council are relying on the Animal Services report to approve our CUP and lease. What a pain..., but we are prevailing.

I'm sorry to burden you with this, but I think a simple and quick recap will suffice.

Please call me if you have any questions.

As an aside, your office never invoiced me for your time, which I much appreciate and am happy to pay for. I thought I'd be back to request your services again in shoeing or for the shot, but have not yet had to return. Please feel welcome to invoice me as you provided a valuable service to me.

I am soliciting your second opinion on a 20 year old Nat Show Horse Mare I own and use in our public riding stable herd. She has a club foot, though has managed it well over her long, busy life. She's been a national-winning western show horse, a

mountain string horse in CO and on our string in Buellton since December. Last week, she came back from a ride (a walk along and across the river) with pronounced lameness in her left front.

Dr. [redacted] from [redacted] blocked it, then radiographed it. His recommendations are below, and the x-rays are attached in a link.

We've had her on [redacted] for 8 days and she's responding well. She show's moderate lameness when lunged on the turn. She walks straight without exhibiting it.

I'm interested in a treatment / shoeing program that will return her to soundness and allow us to keep using her. She currently wears normal steel shoes without pads. Previously, we had her on EZ Care acrylic shoes with a thick sole, metal interior and heart-bar to protect her from stone bruises. Our farrier talked me into metal shoes.

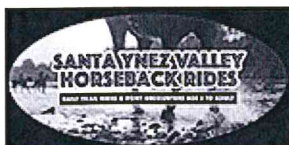
I know there are more aggressive treatments for ringbone, and am curious about the liquid the images found in her hoof. Could this be a slow-progressing access? I'd like to consider all options.
